



#### SPECIFICATIONS AND FIELDS OF EMPLOYMENT

**Stucco Veneziano** is natural decorative paste produced according to old Venetian formulas. With stucco veneziano you can replicate typical Venetian marble style. Stucco Veneziano becomes fully washable three weeks after application. It is non-toxic VOC (0) L/A 200g/I (2010). **Application:** It must be used in system with **NEOPRO primer S** and **Cera Garde** wax.

Thinner: Ready to use

Drying time: touch dry 2 hours, 6 to 8 between coats

**Yield:** 1.2 to 1.5m<sup>2</sup> per 1kg **Flammability:** Not flammable

**S46** If swallowed, immediately contact a doctor and show him the packaging and labeling

Date: Marked on the packaging

#### **COMPOSITION**

Long-seasoning slaked lime, high-selected calcareous filler, and non-toxic additives.

# **METHODS OF APPLICATION**

Surface preparation

The application on lime supports is recommended, but it can also be applied on plaster or by-products, old hydro paints, only if strong and well-fixed, after the application of a coat of **NEOPRO primer S**.

# **Application**

Spread a coat of Stucco Veneziano with a stainless steel smoother so as to level the support; if needed, spread a second coat. Apply little spots of product and then take them away ("put and remove" technique); when the product is going to dry up, press and move to polish, until the desired result is obtained.

**Coloring of the product:** each color in our color chart has been divided into 4 different shades of Stucco Veneziano.

# **TECHNICAL DATA**

Package: 14 lit or 5 lit in polyethylene containers

Preservation: 24 months in the intact packages, away from temperature changes
